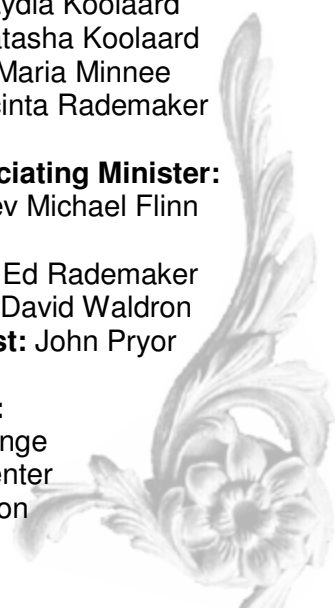

Requirements of the

Husband

- A man shall leave father and mother, and cleave to his wife. Genesis 2v24, Mark 10v28
 - Let every man have his own wife. 1 Cor 7v2
- Husbands shall dwell with their wives according to knowledge, giving honor unto them, as unto the weaker vessel. 1 Peter 3v7
- Husbands love your wives, even as Christ loved the Church, and gave Himself for it. Eph 5v25
 - So ought man to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife, loveth himself. Ephesians 5v28-33
 - Let the husband render unto the wife due benevolence. 1 Cor 7v3. See also 1 Cor 7v33
 - If a husband provide not for his own (wife and children) he is worse than an infidel. 1 Timothy 5v8
- A man shall cheer up his wife. Deuteronomy 24v5
 - Husbands love your wives, and be not bitter against them. Colossians 3v19
- Art thou bound to a wife, seek not to be loosed. 1 Corinthians 7v27
 - Marriage is honorable in all. Hebrews 13v4
 - Let not the husband put away his wife. 1 Corinthians 7v11
 - Let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth. God hateth putting away. Mal 2v15-16
 - It is a wicked act that a man should gain the heart of a woman, and then forsake his wife.

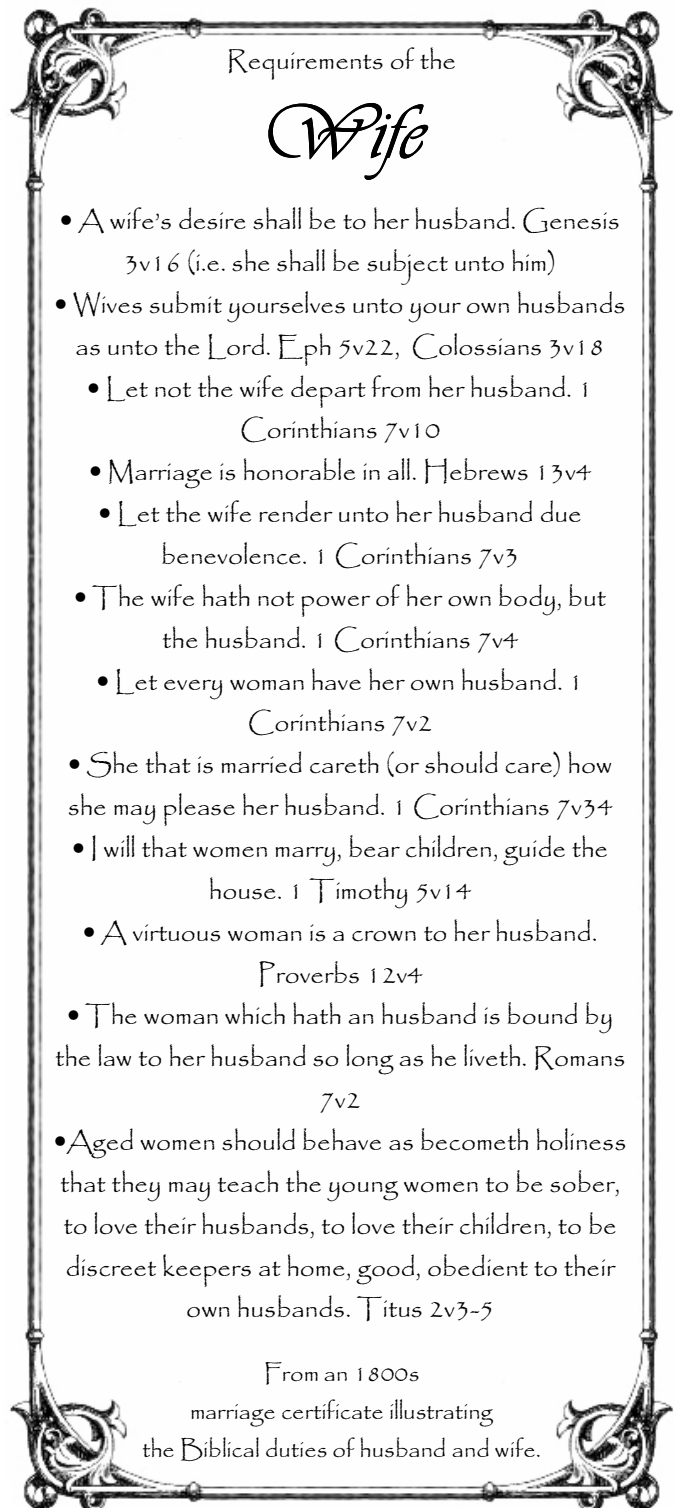
