And for budding scientists, this is **the** platform through which to officially qualify for the Auckland Schools' Science Competition, if they wish.

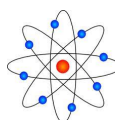

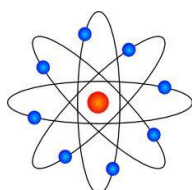

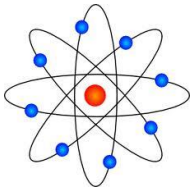

ANIMAL WELFARE! If your entry involves animals, you will probably need to apply to the NZASE Animal Ethics Committee for approval. "Animals" does not include insects but does include fish. Go to www.nzase.org.nz/ethics.html for the information and a link to the application form

HUMAN WELFARE! If your project involves getting humans to test or taste things you need to check the Human ethics guidelines www.rsnz.org/education/science_fairs/humanethicscode.php

ENTRY FEE: \$15 per entry (family maximum of \$40). Several entries may be submitted by the same student with each entry accompanied by a \$15 entry fee.

POSTAL ENTRIES BY 26 JULY: Print out the form, fill it in, make your payment and post to Auckland Home Educators Inc, PO Box 15107, New Lynn, Auckland 0640.

JUDGING: All students - please come and stand by your display:

Thursday 2 August for Experimental and Technology Projects will be judged on Thursday evening, 2nd August. If you are in these categories you need to bring your display and set it up before 6pm. The judges will start carrying out the student interviews at 6:30pm. You will be able to leave once your interview has taken place. The displays will stay set up overnight.

Friday 3 August for Observational Projects

Bring your display and set it up ready for 9am judging. The doors will open at 10.30am for the public to come and look at your displays.

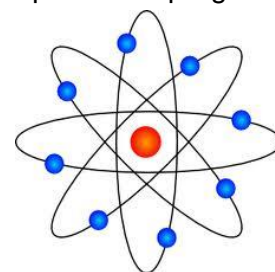
PRIZEGIVING will be at **12pm** and the Fair will continue until **1pm** when you may pack up your display.
